Ballot Information for this Election

- There are **three** Officer positions open in 2024. President, Vice President and Secretary.
- There are **five** Director positions open in 2024 due to appointed positions expiration. The Director candidates receiving the three highest vote counts will fill the regular 3-year terms, then the candidates receiving the fourth and fifth highest count will fill one of the vacant positions.
- The Election Chair position occurs yearly, and is for a one year term.
- No write-ins are allowed, per WAC Bylaws.
- Eligibility to vote: You must be a member in good standing. This means that you must not be suspended and you must be current (paid-up) at the time the ballots are printed.
- The process is based on the following Bylaw: "Only annual members and life members shall be eligible to vote and to hold office; any member in good standing may serve on committees of the WAC."

The ballot box will be at WAC shows in February 24-25 (Puyallup) and March 23-24 (Enumclaw). Mailed ballots must be received in the WAC office by March 15th. Do not include membership renewals or correspondences in the envelope.
