Ballot Information for this Election

- There are **two** Officer positions open in 2025. Vice President and Secretary.
- ◆ There are **three** Director positions open in 2025. The Director candidates receiving the three highest vote counts will fill the regular 3-year terms.
- The Election Chair position occurs yearly, and is for a one year term.
- No write-ins are allowed, per WAC Bylaws.
- Eligibility to vote: You must be a member in good standing. This means that you must not be suspended and you must be current (paid-up) at the time the ballots are printed.
- The process is based on the following Bylaw: "Only annual members and life members shall be eligible to vote and to hold office; any member in good standing may serve on committees of the WAC."

The ballot box will be at WAC show February 21-23 in the Pavilion at the Puyallup show.

Mail in ballots to: WAC 2025 Election P.O. Box 400 Sumner, Washington 98390. They must be post marked on or before March 23rd, 2025.

Scanned email ballots must be sent as an attachment with the subject line stating: Election Ballot to: Washingtonarmscollectors.org by or before March 23rd.

Do not include membership renewals or correspondences in the envelope.
